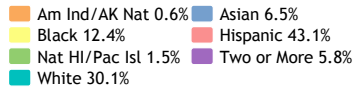
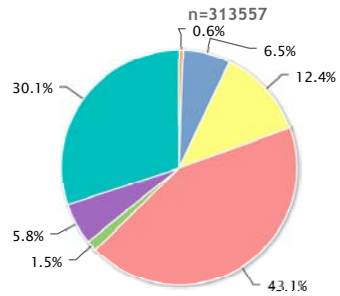
Algebra I Enrollment in 7th or 8th



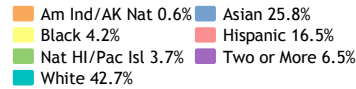
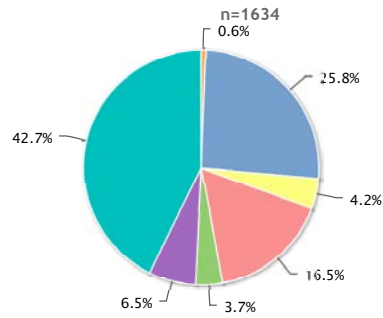

SAT/ACT Enrollment



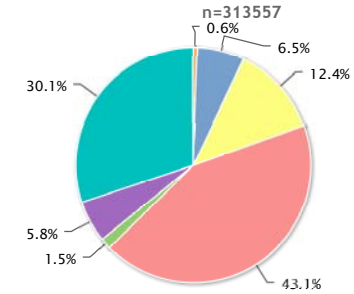

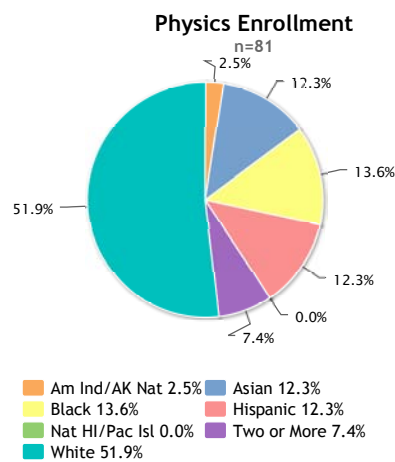
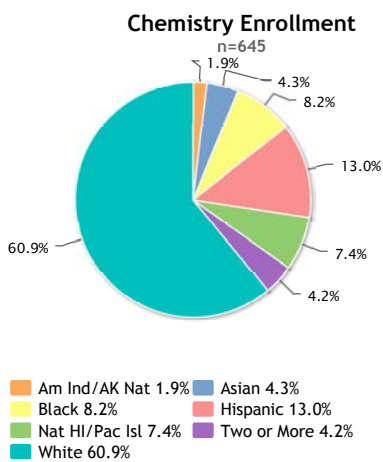
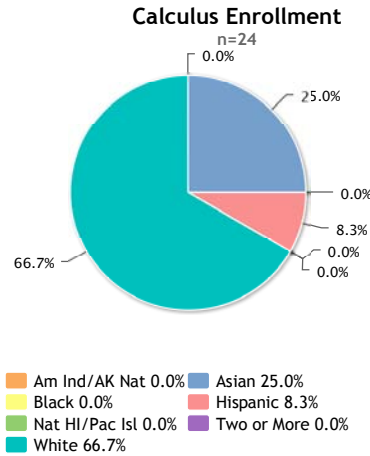
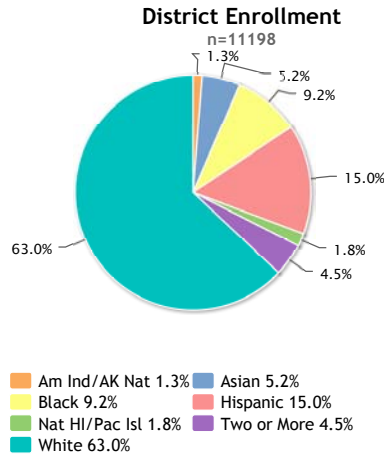


Algebra I Enrollment in 7th or 8th

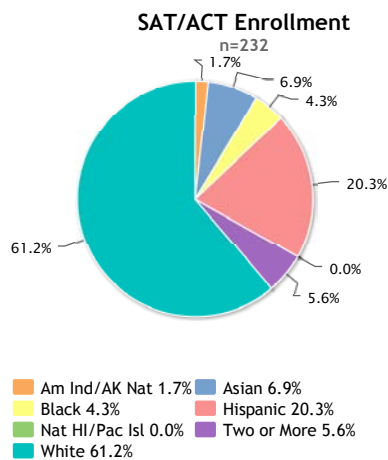
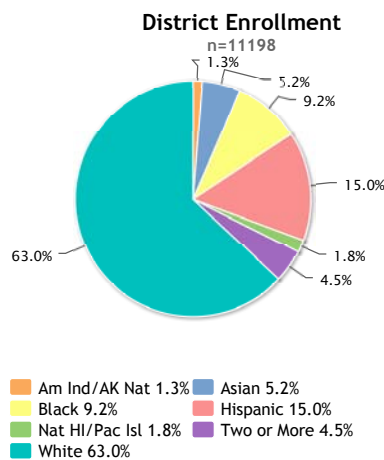
